

# SilicoNPV 2026: Upload Your Paper to TIB-OP

Dear authors,

Between **March 16, 2026**, and **April 18, 2026**, you will be able to upload your paper to the proceedings publisher's website, TIB-OP. Since the authors retain copyright to their works, the upload must be carried out by you personally. During the upload process, you will have to agree to the copyright notice and license agreement. Mind that all content is subject to unrestricted reuse with regard to **CC-BY 4.0**.

**Only the papers that have been presented as an oral or poster presentation at the conference are eligible for publication in the conference proceedings**

Below are the next steps to submit your article:

## 1. Registration

Go to the TIB-OP website (follow this link: <https://www.tib-op.org/ojs/index.php/index>) and register, or use your existing login information.

## 2. Start Your Submission

- Read the information on the page "[About the Conference Proceedings Series](#)" and "[Privacy Statement](#)" thoroughly before starting the process.
- Click on "About > Conference Proceedings Submissions" on the upper left corner, and go through the **Preparation Checklist**, **Author Guidelines** and **Instructions** carefully. Adjust/create your submission files with these requirements in mind.
- We only accept submissions following the [LaTeX](#) or [Word Templates](#) provided by TIB-OP. Format your submission within either of these formats before uploading them on the TIB platform.
- You must also upload all **figures** separately as **JPG/PNG** files or as **archives**.
- Equations should also be uploaded as separate **KaTeX files**.
- In order to start the upload process, click on "Make a New Conference Proceedings Submission" or follow this upload link: <https://www.tib-op.org/ojs/index.php/siliconpv/about/submissions>
- Read and acknowledge that you have completed the requirements before proceeding with the next step.
- Once you agree to the terms of the copyright declaration, your data will be collected and stored according to the privacy policy.

### **3. Upload Submission**

Upload all files required for the editorial evaluation of your submission, including:

- Conference paper as a Word or LaTeX document
- Equations in KaTeX format
- Figures as jpeg / png files, or as archives

### **4. Choose Your Section**

### **5. Enter Metadata**

- Prefix and Title
- Subtitle
- Abstract
- List of Contributors
- Keywords
- Supporting Agencies
- References
- Funding Data

### **6. Confirm**

The SiliconPV conference papers will undergo the following stages. A paper is accepted for publication if it successfully passes all of the following stages in a timely manner:

1. Plagiarism Check (including self-plagiarism)
2. Scientific Review (first round)
3. Scientific Review (second round)
4. Layout Review
5. Production (by TIB-OP Editors)

After finalizing your submission, you will be notified by the editors once your paper is in the scientific review.

## **Important Notes**

Please note that, both the scientific and layout review are **conducted exclusively via the TIB platform**. Kindly ensure that you receive notifications from TIB and mark the sender as trusted in your email provider if necessary.

All papers must follow the TIB guidelines provided above and comply with typical quality standards for scientific publications and English language.

Papers that do not meet the scientific and English language standards, were not presented on site, are submitted after the deadline, or are being published in SOLMAT are not going to be considered for the SilicoNPV conference proceedings publication.

Please upload your paper **until April 18, 2026 23.59 CET**, to ensure timely publication.
